



## Guidance for the Daycares during Utah's 'Moderate Risk' Phase\*

Updated April 30, 2020

Effective May 1, 2020

- Follow all employer guidelines outlined in the General Business Guidelines
- Enhance cleaning and disinfecting
- Encourage children to stay 6 feet apart as much as possible
- Groups must be restricted to groups of 20 unless a wall can physically separate each group
- Limit mixing the groups of children (keep in separate rooms, allow on the playground at different times)
- Encourage curbside drop off and pick up
- All individuals must wash hands with soap and running water upon arrival
- Don't use toys that can't be washed and disinfected
- Children and staff should stay home if they're sick
- Children and staff should be checked for symptoms of COVID-19, and get their temperature checked upon entering the facility; symptomatic individuals must be sent home
- If there is a confirmed case associated with the facility, the facility must be closed and the local health department alerted
- All high-touch surfaces should be cleaned and disinfected after each use (e.g., toys, keyboards, desks, remote controls)
